



Tumacácori & Tubac 1 Day, Tu Parks

Learn about Arizona history where it happened! Two historical sites only minutes apart bring state standards to life. Includes science, art, geography, mathematics, language arts and more.

Tumacácori Mission

Learn about life in a Spanish mission. Discover the many people and cultures who were a part of the mission community from the Spanish missionaries to the O'odham tribe.

Your students will be challenged to think like a mission resident. They will test their skills ranging from language and mathematics to agriculture and diplomacy.

Students will have the opportunity to explore the mission grounds including church, storeroom, orchard, cemetery, museum, and more.

Tubac Presidio

Tubac Presidio was a military outpost that fostered the growing community of Tubac. Meet STEAM learning objectives while discovering frontier life in Southern Arizona.

Visit a historical schoolhouse and an underground exhibit. Explore the restored Rojas House to witness adobe home living in the 1800's, and the historic Otero Hall with the world's only mud wagon on display.

Your students will have the opportunity to dress in 1800's period clothing, design their own mode of transportation, and immerse themselves into the past.

Students spend 90 minutes at each site with a lunch break. All grade levels are welcome. Groups arrive at 9:00 a.m. and depart at 2:00 p.m. At least 1 chaperone per 10 students.
