**Setting:** 11 acres at 3500 feet elevation featuring a visitor center, museum, underground archaeological display, 3 National Register of Historic Places buildings: 1885 Schoolhouse, Otero Hall, Rojas House; picnic area; and trailhead for the Juan Bautista de Anza National Historic Trail.
